Roscoe Mitchell. Thomas Buckner and Gerald Oshita (1942-1992) founded the trio SPACE in 1979 as a vehicle for the exploration of new concepts in composition and improvisation. From that time until Gerald Oshita's untimely death, they appeared in concert and at festivals throughout the U.S. and Europe. Highlights include the Actual Music Festival in London, Moers Music in Germany and New Music America in Chicago, as well as the New York Public Theatre. This 2 CD set is a reissue of the two records by the trio originally released on 1750 Arch Records. The first, New Music for Woodwinds and Voice, presents compositions by Mitchell and Oshita which employ varying degrees of improvisation. The second, An Interesting Breakfast Conversation, is devoted entirely to group improvisation.
